Entry fee \$35 (via EFTPOS on the day)

Per night: Unpowered camp sites \$15 + \$5 power; Hut accommodation \$20 BYO bedding

Sausage sizzle and presentation afterwards*

On Day: Awards for 1st each range (TR, FS, FO and F/TR – not graded).

On Day: Awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd for aggregate (TR, FS, FO and F/TR – not graded).

Bisley Trophy (perpetual, donated by Steve and Donna Negus) aggregate winners (TR, FS, FO and F/TR – not graded) determined by the highest aggregate on the day.

Match will follow NRAA SSR's, Section 4.1.5 - SSRs-Current.pdf (nraa.com.au)

2 shooters per target (mixed left- and right-handed shooters, bench shooters will be squadded together if possible), order as advised by RO. 3 shooters per target if an odd number of shooters.

- Competitors score for one another.
- 5-minute preparation time, targets will be available for sighting, no gear is to be placed on mound until RO calls competitors forward.
- 60 seconds per shot.

Bisley Trophy Matches: The Bisley Trophy Match will be shot on Kongsberg Electronic Targets, with two shooters per target Bisley Style (a maximum of 18 shooters per detail is therefore possible). If more than 18 shooters compete, the details will be split into disciplines where possible. The winner (for trophy engraving) in each discipline (TR, FS, FO and FTR) will be determined by the highest aggregate score. No other match / practice will be shot alongside.

Important: If parking along the road to the SSAA range, all rifles MUST be covered and contained within a suitable rifle case or soft bag for transporting to and from your vehicle and the 900m mound.
